Checking My Work in English Class

- 1. Using the wrong tense
 - Past tense/present tense
- 2. Subject-verb agreement
 - For example, the sentence "The people *is* coming to the game tomorrow" is incorrect. It should be, "The people *are* coming to the game tomorrow."
- 3. Grammar mistakes
 - Its/it's, their/there, than/then, your/you're, etc.
- 4. Not answering the question/sticking to the prompt
 - Do you address the prompt you were given? Did you go off subject?
- 5. Punctuation
 - Commas, semicolons, etc.
- 6. Run-on Sentences
 - A run-on sentence could be when two or more independent clauses, or complete sentences, are joined without appropriate punctuation.
